A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA GRANDE, OREGON, ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM PARKING AND TOWING FEES AND FEES FOR PARKING PERMITS; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NUMBER 4268, SERIES 2003, AND ALL OTHER RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JULY 1, 2009.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, has adopted an Ordinance known by its short title as the "Parking Ordinance," providing for the regulation of parking in the City of La Grande, Oregon; and,

WHEREAS, the "Parking Ordinance" provides that the City Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, may, by Resolution, set fees for certain fines and permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, that fees for certain fines and permits shall be and hereby are established as follows:

Section 1. PARKING PERMITS AND RESIDENTIAL PARKING ZONE APPLICATION FEE
Parking permits may be issued to allow parking in excess of the posted time in marked areas
only. Individuals and businesses may purchase permits to park in posted areas for the following
fees. All permits expire December 31, of the year for which the permit is issued.

Permit Purchased for the Period April through December	\$45.00
Permit Purchased for the Period October through December	\$15.00
Residential Parking Zone Application Fee	\$25.00

Annual Residential Zone Visitor Permit	No Charge

Section 2. VEHICLE TOWING

Administrative towing fees shall be FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$50.00), payable to the City of La Grande. Actual vehicle towing and storage fees shall be established by and payable to the appropriate tow company.

SECTION 3. FINES

An individual or registered owner of a vehicle convicted of violating the following Sections of the "Parking Ordinance," shall be subject to a minimum fine, as follows:

Section 7; Disabled Parking	\$ 75.00
Section 8; Parking Motor Vehicles in a City Park	\$ 21.00
Section 9; Parking, Storing, or Abandoning of Motor Vehicles on City Street(s) Over Forty-Eight (48) Hours	\$ 21.00
Section 10; Parking Regulations, Except Subsection (n)	\$ 21.00
Section 10, Subsection (n); Restricted Time Zones If Paid Within Thirty (30) Days of Issuance	\$ 21.00 \$ 15.00
Section 10, Subsection (n); Violations in a Residential Parking Zone	\$ 21.00
Section 11; Planting Strips	\$ 21.00
Section 12; Position of Vehicle When Parallel Parked	\$ 21.00
Section 14. Subsection (e); Impoundment and Detention ("Boot" Fee)	\$ 40.00
