

MONTHLY INCIDENT STATISTICS

Incident Categories:

Fire: Incidents that have been categorized as fire responses may be a variety of the following types of calls; structure fires (both residential and commercial), flue fires, outdoor fires, wildland fires, smoke from an unknown source, natural gas leaks, carbon monoxide exposures, power lines down, fire alarm activations, smoke detector activations, and water flow alarms.

EMS: Incidents that have been categorized as EMS responses are calls for emergency medical services, inter-facility transfers, and medically assisting other agencies within our response area.

MVC: Incidents that have been categorized as MVC responses are calls that consist of motor vehicle crashes (both with and without injuries).

Public Assist: Incidents that have been categorized as Public Assist responses are calls for services consisting of lift assists, people who are in distress but not otherwise injured, and assisting law enforcement.

False Alarms/Cancelled/UTL: Incidents that have been categorized in this section are responses where the units were cancelled by dispatch or another agency, the call was unintentional, or responding units were unable to locate the incident (for example a vehicle crash that occurred and the parties involved left the scene).
