The Union County Warming Station (UCWS) began in 2017 as an informal, volunteer community-run effort to provide a safe, warm place to stay the night during the coldest months of the year for any Union County resident who needs it. Leadership then secured funding to hire two full-time, year-round staff, Maggie Mayhem and Doug Whipple to expand our services to provide showers, laundry, and daytime resource navigation. We will continue to provide overnight shelter, food, cold weather supplies, and clothing during the winter season.

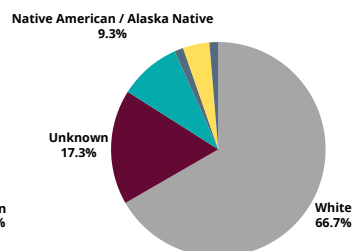

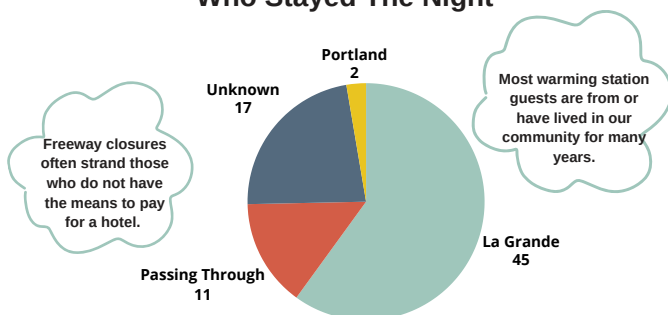
Gender
