**EXPLANATION**: The U.S. Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration (EDA) is awarding the Liberty Theatre Foundation \$585.534 of funding to complete the project. In February, 2023, the

awarding the Liberty Theatre Foundation \$585,534 of funding to complete the project. In February, 2023, the Agency granted the District Manager the authority to draft and sign an amendment to the Liberty Theatre Loan agreement granting the EDA first priority lien position on the property and to sign any related documents required by the EDA. The process to review the grant documents by EDA has taken longer than anticipated and the funding has not yet been made available, which has also delayed the project. In reviewing the current amended agreement, it was noted the following language precludes an extension. However, per the City Attorney, the Agency and Foundation could still agree to modify the agreement.

AMENDMENTS – WRITING REQUIRED. The Foundation and the Agency or its assigns, hereby expressly reserve all rights to amend any provisions of this Agreement, to consent to or waive any departure from the provisions of this loan Agreement, to amend or consent to, or waive departure from the provisions of the Note, and to release or otherwise deal with any collateral security for payment of the Note provided, however, that all such amendments be in writing and executed by the Agency or its assigns, and the Foundation, with the exception of the date of maturity of June 30, 2023, which may not be extended for any reason.

Under the circumstances, extending the agreement for one year would be in the best interest of the Foundation and the Agency. Based on the explicit language, formal action by the Agency to approve the extension is required. The amendment will also include whatever provisions are necessary to meet the EDA requirements, as has already been authorized by the Agency.

The District Manager recommends the Agency approve this action as presented.
